
# User Manual for XF770/XF690 Plus Folding Electric Bike

# **Bike Computer Operation:**





1. Turn on/ Turn off bike computer: Press bike computer;



for 3 seconds to turn or turn off the

2. Turn on/ Turn off bike front light: Press




to turn on or turn off front light.

3. Active walk mode: After turning on the bike computer and press to active the walk mode.



4. Increase/ Decrease PAS /Throttle Power Delivery Level: After turning on the bike





to increase the PAS Level and Press



PAS level.



to turn on or turn off the horn.

6. Speed Unit Setting ( How to change the Speed Unit to Miles or KMS ?)

After turning on the bike computer and press





together for 3 seconds

to enter setting mode,



to switch P level setting from P01 to P02;





change the P02 code from 00000 to 00001 by press or ,the speed unit will be in MPH or KMP;

# **Brakes and Throttle Operation:**



A: Shimano 7/9 Speeds Rear Gears Lever;

B: Front Brake Lever

C: Twist Throttle



A: Rear Brake Lever

B: Horn/Front Light Button

C: Bike Computer and Control Unit

D: Shimano 3 Speeds Front Gears Lever (XF770);

# **Battery Removing and Charging:**

Charge Hours: 5-7 Hours;
Charger Light Red: Charging
Charger Light Green: Full Charge





There are **TWO** ways to charge the battery:


A: Charge battery directly in the bike frame;

B: Take out battery out from bike frame and charge battery separately;

In order to do so, follow below steps take out the battery from bike frame:

1) Open the folding frame locker. Find the latch on the folding frame locker.





Press and pull the latch at forward by one hand and pull out the locker by another hand.

2) Find the battery key at the under face of bike frame and make twice clockwise turns;



When battery key cylinder pulls back fully and then take off the key

from bike frame and battery.





3) Fold bike frame and use the battery finger hook to take out the battery;





### **Pedals Installment:**



WR/R is for Right Crank; WL/L is for Left Crank;





Slightly hands in the Right pedal into Right crank arm first and then use # 15 wrench to fasten pedals firmly in clockwise direction. Do the same with Left pedal on Left crank arm too in anti-clockwise direction.
